

YOLANDA SONNABEND is an artist who designs for The Royal Ballet. Her designs include *L'Invitation au Voyage*, choreographed by Michael Corder, and Kenneth MacMillan's ballets: *Rituals*; *Valley of Shadows*; *My Brother*; *My Sisters*; *Symphony*; *Requiem*; *Playground* and *Different Drummer*; and Anthony Dowell's production of *Swan Lake*; all for The Royal Ballet and *The Rite of Spring* for English National Ballet. She recently designed *Antony and Cleopatra* for the RSC. For many years Yolanda Sonnabend has taught at the Slade School of Art and has exhibited at the Whitechapel and Serpentine Galleries. In 2000 she won the prestigious Garrick Club prize with her portrait of Sir Kenneth MacMillan, and her portraits are represented in the National Portrait Gallery.
